YOUR COLLEGE-PLANNING JOURNEY, YEAR BY YEAR

The college-planning process begins freshman year and continues through graduation, with an expert college counselor working with you one on one every step of the way. Representatives from colleges and universities across the country visit our campus each fall, connecting our students to the many options available in higher education.

Freshman Year: During your first year of high school, you will be introduced to the concepts of researching colleges, and using the Naviance database and the College Board’s Big Future. Testing includes the Aspire test, a version of the ACT.

Sophomore Year: In year two, you will take the PSAT for the first time, the Aspire a second time, and review your results in individual meetings with your college counselor. In addition, you will initiate a career search through Naviance. A special College Night for students and parents offers an opportunity to learn and ask more questions about the process.

Junior Year: As your college decision becomes closer to reality, it is time to work on your college resume and applications. You will have more frequent individual meetings with your college counselor—and your parents will also join you for a review of your course plan and college goals.

Senior Year: With graduation in sight, it is time to dig into the details, including discussing collegiate financial-aid procedures and assistance with your college counselor. Senior College Night also provides a chance to discuss the college application process including those tools found in Naviance.
